

Mahoning Soil & Water District Seeks 2 Volunteer Board Members

YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio (August 9, 2019) -- The Mahoning County Soil & Water Conservation District is seeking applicants for two seats on its volunteer board of supervisors, the five-member body that governs the District.

The new members will be elected to three-year terms by a special countywide public election planned for October.

Board supervisors must be U.S. citizens and Mahoning County residents or Mahoning County property owners over the age of 18. They set the direction of the organization and act as ambassadors for the District in their communities, providing supervision to the District administrator and oversight of fiscal decisions and funding activities.
